

**IAABO Board #11**  
**General Membership Minutes from December 20, 2006 Meeting**

**7:00PM: Meeting is opened.**

**I) Interpreter Update:**

- The meeting began with Layne Drexel providing hand-outs describing instructions to timer's and scorer's and explained the handouts.
- He discussed 6 minute vs. 8 minute quarters. This is the athletic director's decision. We are contracted to do 8 minute quarters.
- A \$1 raise per game by DIAA.
- Hair bands and pre-wrap are not legal as head bands, however, they are legal if worn as a hair-control device and can be of any color.
- Mouthpiece rule is for DIAA schools only. CYM has same rule, except that they allow the mouthpiece to be of any color, including white or clear.
- Emphasized that all officials insist that the coaches box is adhered to.
- Various officiating situations were discussed.
- Orange hand-out provided - most missed questions on the Fall 2006 exam. Discussion followed.
- Asked that all officials enforce head band rule.
- Pre-game, to include officials pre-game and coaches/captains, is for all games – Middle School, Freshman, JV, and Varsity, CYM.
- Announced that the board had discussed a donation to the player from Caravel. Mike provided 4 Philly tickets and would pass around a hat for donations.

**II) President :**

- The minutes from previous meetings were approved.
- Mike DiMuzio emphasized getting correct team, level, #, where, and when for CYM technical fouls.
- DIAA has granted permission for the headpiece worn by a Glasgow girl player. Proper documentation should be provided.
- Names of those who did not work the appropriate number of scrimmages were read. All officials must work at least 3 scrimmages.
- Pam Cotman needs help on scorer's table for Diamond State. Contact Pam directly if you can help.
